In 1747 a young French officer, Captain Jules Armand de Mont Choisy, discovered the ideal location for a permanent outpost in the North of Mauritius, on the shores of the perfectly formed natural harbour of Grand Baie.

Ever since, the unique natural advantages, temperate weather and abundant beauty of Le Parc de Mont Choisy has attracted remarkable people from all over the world, a fascinating cast of swashbuckling buccaneers, ambitious empire-builders, medical heroes and adventurous aviators.

Some, like M. Lambert, came seeking fortune and found love. Others, like world-renowned Austrian explorer Ida Pfeiffer, came in search of peace and beauty, while others sought adventure, as did Maurice Samat when he landed the first international flight to Mauritius on what was then Mont Choisy's racecourse.

All have left their signature somewhere on this intriguing estate, from the huge wrought-iron Friendship Gates, a gift from King Rokoto of Madagascar, to the stone bi-plane hangar on its southern boundary.



MONT CHOISY BEACH

Mont Choisy Beach, just a few minutes walk from the western gates of the estate, is among the most beautiful in Mauritius. Stretching almost three kilometres from Trou aux Biches to Pointe aux Canonniers, this is the island's longest beach: a gently curving strand of golden sand lined with a shady grove of filao trees on one side and by gentle, crystal-clear aquamarine water on the other. It's the perfect beach for long walks, frequent swims and romantic sunsets.

We have used the term 'barefoot luxury' to define the quality of the environment we are creating at Mont Choisy. Our choice of materials, finishes and colours engage with the environment to create a magical and sensual experience... A timeless and elegant dream getaway.

Designing in Mauritius is both similar and totally different at the same time. Similar in that one wants to capture the spirit of the place and different in that on an island, luxury is about tranquility, space and relaxation.

Our simple palette of natural materials will be allowed to age and acquire a patina. Naturally bleached timber cladding will be complemented by walls of local stone. Interiors will feature granite countertops and travertine tiles. And everywhere, the principle of integrating indoor and outdoor living into a seamless experience will be echoed by the integration of the built environment into the magical landscape of Mont Choisy.














PHASE I - SITE PLAN

VILLAS DU PARC

The Villas du Parc feature large private gardens that open onto a lush, tropical paradise where children can explore to their heart's content. Each villa will feature three en-suite bedrooms on the first floor, while the ground floor configuration allows for a fourth bedroom or a family room and study.

LA PENINSULE

With spacious interiors opening onto view decks and terraces, these two and three bedroom apartments and penthouses are arranged in intimate blocks around four massive swimming pools to which Antoni has added cabana pavilions to create magical and intimate holiday spaces.






GOLF COURSE DESIGN >> by Peter Matkovich

His uniquely organic design philosophy, which he describes as 'listening to the land,' has succeeded in creating courses that have won acclaim and affection across Southern Africa.

At Mont Choisy, his celebration of the landscape is true to form and revels in the variety of the scenery. To the majestically treed area around the Clubhouse, the beautiful rolling grasslands and the archetypically Mauritian outcrops of black volcanic rock, Peter has added the charm of tropical groves and palm-lined lakes that add drama and excitement to the challenge.

In keeping with the standard set in Peter's Mauritian course, Golf du Chateau, Mont Choisy promises golfers a truly great golfing experience, in a breathtaking setting and is clearly set to become one of the most popular golf courses on the island.

The largest villas are contemporary to their core, with a seductive hint of pure island style.

VILLAS DU GOLF

Stefan Antoni's Mauritian signature villas look out over the Mont Choisy golf course creating seamless green vistas of endless relaxation. These sumptuous but elegantly simple double-storey homes set a whole new standard of indoor outdoor living, with pools that slide into living areas and rooms that run effortlessly to the horizons. Le Parc de Mont Choisy is an approved project by the Board of Investments under the Investment Promotion (Real Estate Development Scheme) Regulation of 2007 – which means that foreign buyers and their immediate families will qualify for permanent Mauritian residence.

Mauritius already attracts around 900 000 tourists per year and aims to increase tourism by 50% over the next five years, with its new airport opening in 2013, upgrades to the road network constantly in progress and an ever-increasing number of new shopping malls and entertainment facilities.

The island is connected to the SA-SAT-3 fibre optic cable, enabling high bandwidth connectivity with Europe and Asia. This, coupled with the fact that there are daily flights to Europe, South Africa and Asia, means that Mauritius is ideally positioned to do business on an international level.

Mauritius has been recognized as the one of the best administered economies in Africa and offers an ideal environment in which to do business. This is partly due to the low level of taxation, with a flat corporate tax rate of 15%. In addition, there is no inheritance tax, no capital gains tax and Double Taxation Agreements have been concluded with 33 countries, including the United Kingdom, France, South Africa, India and China.
